

QUARTERLY COLLECTIONS

Q1 WISCONSIN HUMANE SOCIETY

Founded in 1879, the Wisconsin Humane Society (WHS) has been saving lives of animals in need for more than 140 years. WHS is a 501(c)(3) organization that operates animal shelters in Milwaukee, Ozaukee, Racine, Door, and Brown Counties, as well as a spay/neuter clinic in West Allis.

WHS is community-focused with programs that include a pet food bank, youth programs to educate & inspire the next generation, a foster program for animals in domestic violence situations, dog training classes, and other outreach programs.



Q2 THE WOMEN'S CENTER

Founded in 1977, the mission of The Women's Center (TWC) is to provide safety, shelter, and support to empower all impacted by domestic abuse, sexual violence, child abuse, and trafficking.

As Waukesha County's only agency of its kind in a county that spans 580 square miles, TWC provides a range of life-saving and life-changing programs and services that heal and empower adults and children on their paths to build a future free from violence.



Each year the EIG Charitable Foundation, with suggestions from EIG team members, selects four nonprofit organizations (NPOs) to be the beneficiaries of EIG's quarterly collection drives.

Q3 SOLES FOR JESUS

Founded in 2009, Soles For Jesus (SFJ) exists to share the love of Christ by distributing shoes to the underserved in sub Saharan Africa.

Shoes are a basic luxury that people take for granted every day as we choose our favorite pair from our closet floor. It is estimated that over one billion pairs of unworn shoes are taking up space in U.S. basements and closets. Some are outdated or outgrown, but many of them are in good condition and considered a treasure in a developing country.



Q4 CHRISTMAS CLEARING COUNCIL

Since 1949, The Christmas Clearing Council of Waukesha County has promoted and coordinated giving to families in need during the Christmas season. They provide a clearinghouse that matches families with area groups, businesses, and individuals who wish to help families less fortunate.

In 2022, The Christmas Clearing Council coordinated giving to more than 2,100 families and 4,800 children in Waukesha County.



THEELS TEAN

Philanthropy is one of the core values that EIG lives by as a company and is supported by each of our team members. Beginning in 2019, on an employee's work anniversary they are gifted \$1000 to donate to up to two charities of their choice. The nonprofits who have received these donations represent a wide range of causes, nicely reflecting the values of each of our team members.



Another benefit each EIG employee receives is one day per year that can be used to volunteer for the organization of their choice. Team members can choose to do this work on their own or as a team, bringing coworkers together in service. Many team members serve on various boards of directors for nonprofit organizations and/or volunteer their time regularly outside of these EIG encouraged volunteer opportunities.






